Entertainment Tax for **City tours**



As of **1 January 2020**
the Entertainment Tax
for City tours is effective



A city tour is an **organised** tour on foot or with the use of transportation (for example a bike or segway).

Who has to pay the tax?

The organiser of tours will have to pay the tax. This could be a guide, the person hiring the guide, or the person providing the resources to have a city tour without a guide.



Per participant, the organiser of city tours will have to pay **1,50 euros** Entertainment Tax for City tours.

What do you have to do?

- You will receive a declaration form after every three months.
- Please return the completed declaration form and make the payment of the tax within a month after receiving the form.
- In the declaration form you state how many people participated in your city tours during the previous three months.
- You can decide when to appeal for the exemption for 250 participants.



Each fiscal year an **exemption for 250 people** is granted per organiser of city tours.
