Development of a 'Blue Charter' for Marseille with the involvement of cruise lines and other key cruise stakeholders to sign off on sustainable future developments such as "Provide shore-to-ship power for vessels at berth by 2024", "Zero-Smoke Port Calls" amongst other initiatives
