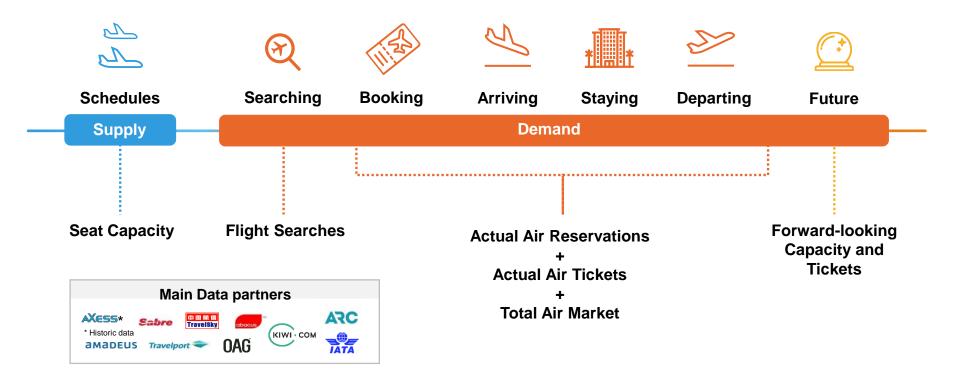

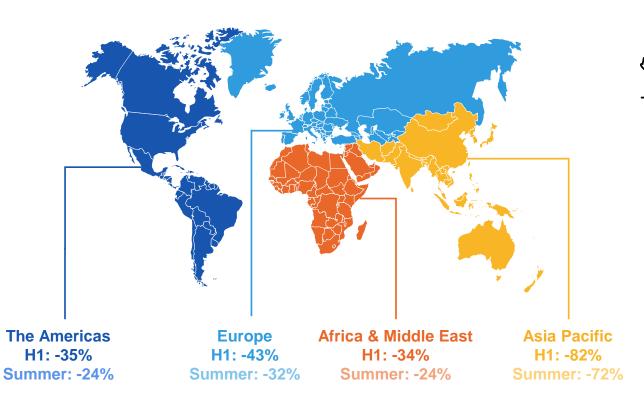




Europe is catching up with the Americas and Africa and the Middle-East

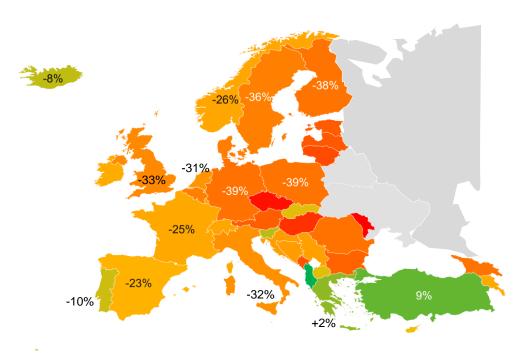




Arrivals to some destinations in Southern Europe surpass pre-pandemic levels

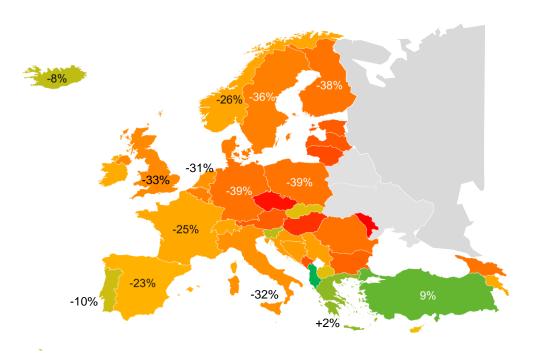

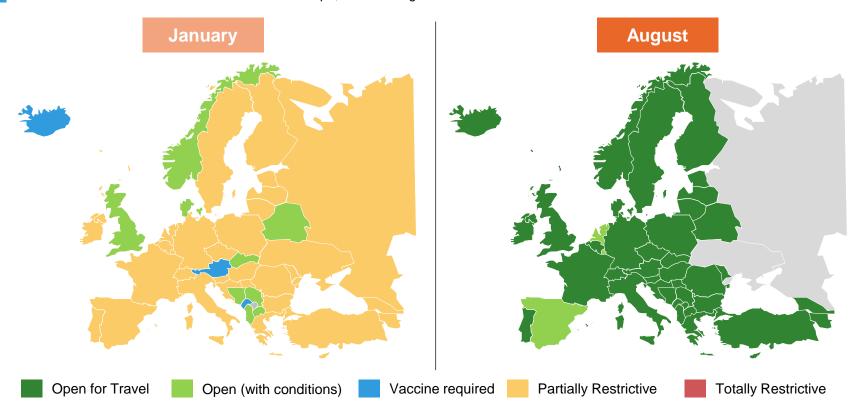




Europe has almost fully reopened borders



Travel restrictions for international travellers to Europe, as of 29 August 2022





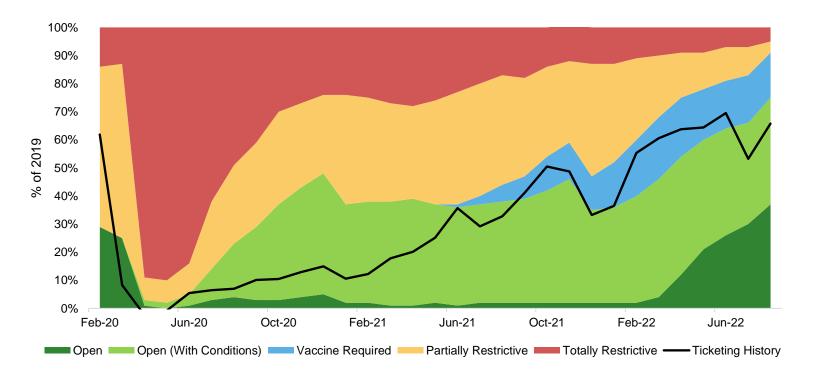


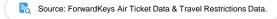


When travel restrictions disappear, bookings (usually) go up



Issued tickets for air travel, as of 31 Aug; compared with 2019







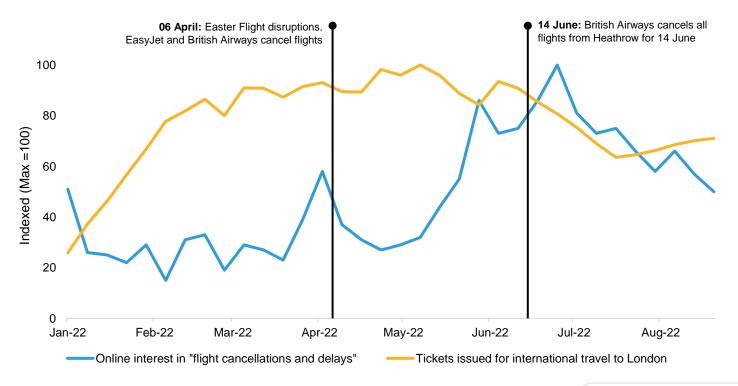




London: Flight cancellations damaged traveller confidence

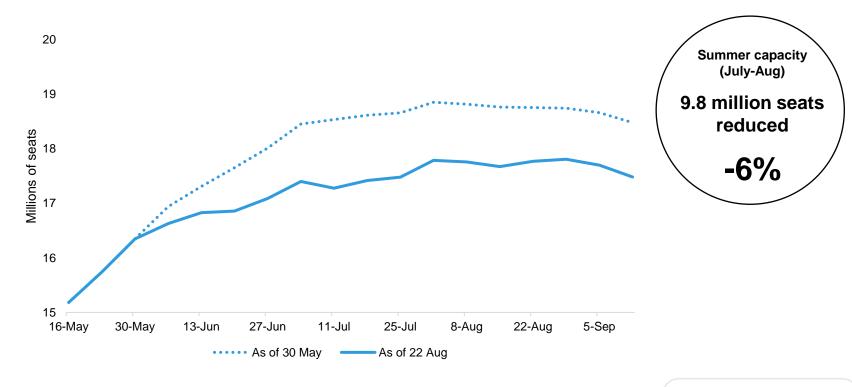




Airlines reduce summer capacity amid European airport chaos

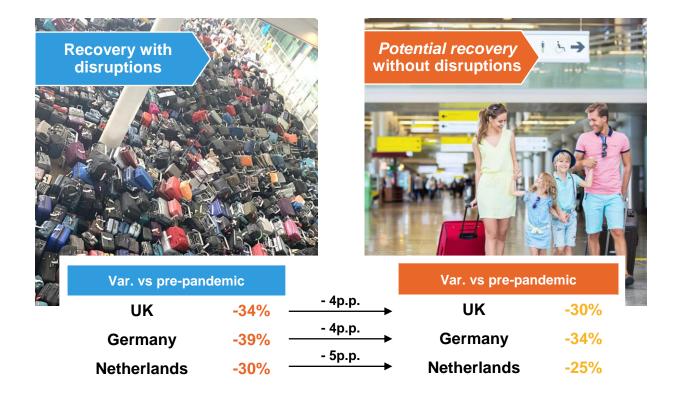




Impact of flight cancellations on touristic arrivals in the UK, Netherlands and Germany



International arrivals in the UK, Netherlands and Germany between June and August 2022; recovery as variation of 2019





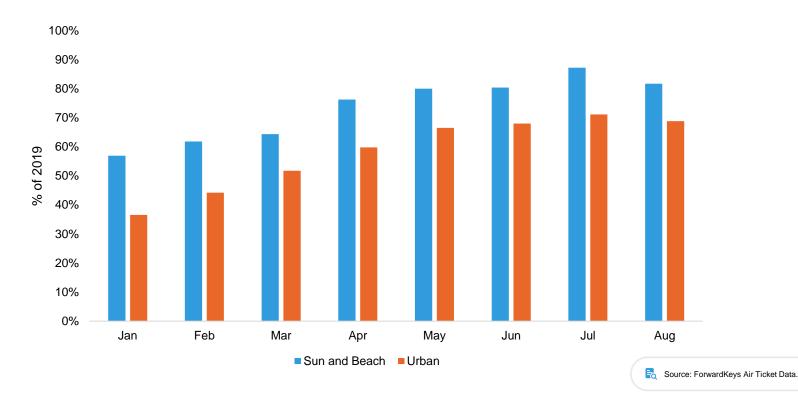




European "Sun and Beach" destinations are more recovered



International arrivals to Europe, year-to-date; % of 2019









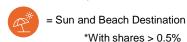

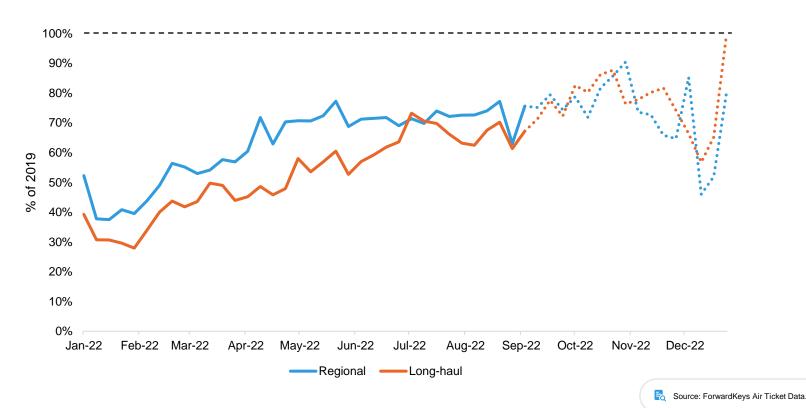

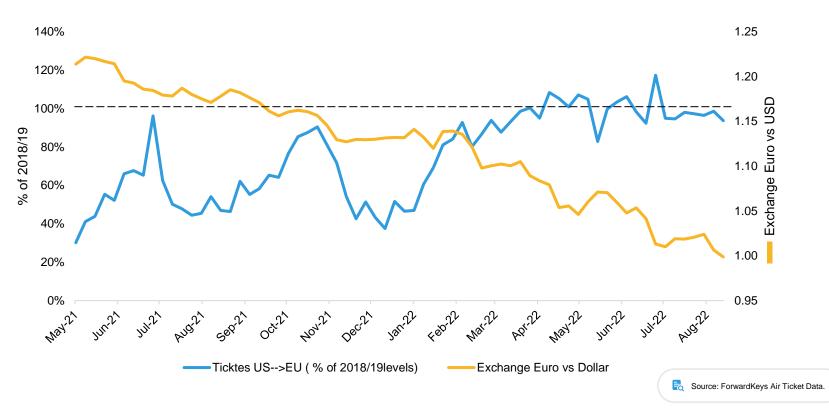




Euro vs USD Exchange rate proves favorable for transatlantic travel



Based on flight bookings between 12 May 2021 and 30 Aug 2022 for arrivals between the US and the EU, vs same period in 2018/19



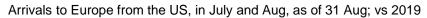




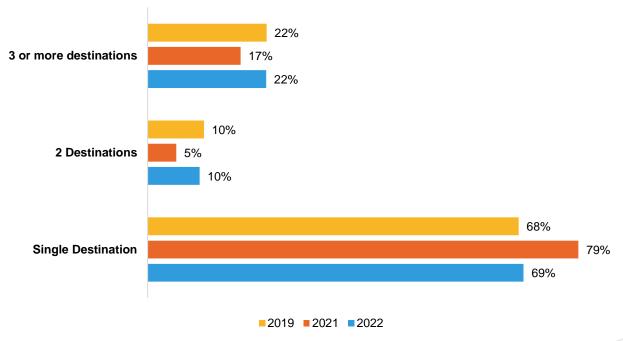

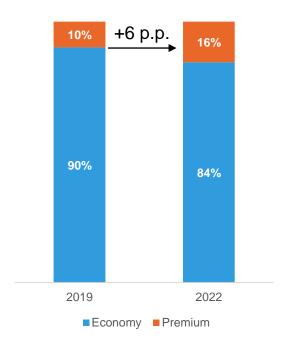

Shares of cabin classes for LATAM travellers











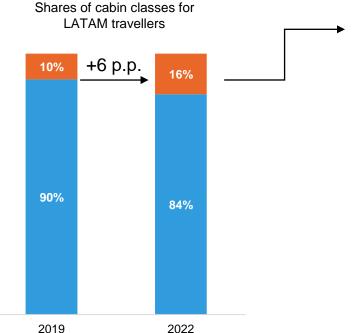

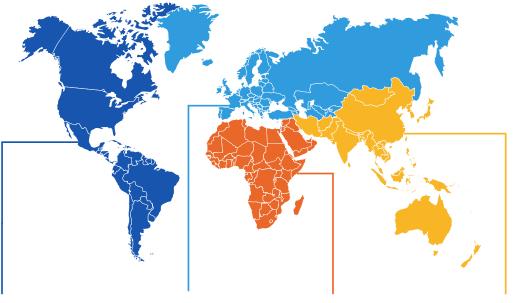

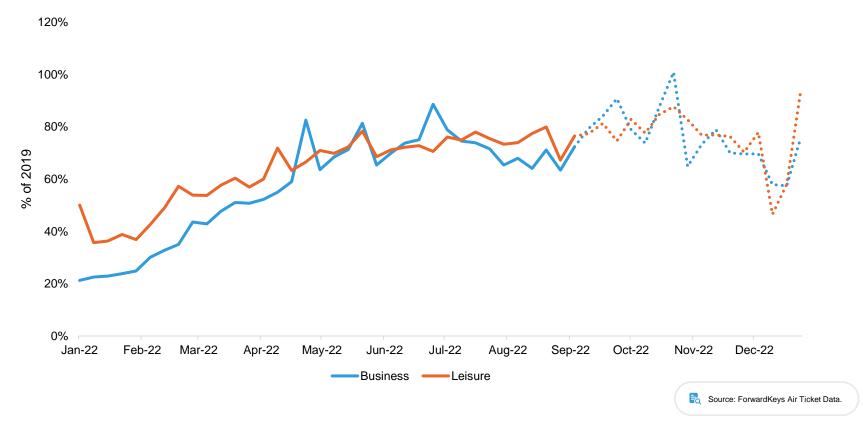




Leisure travel is still driving the recovery, but business travel has caught up



International arrivals and on-the-book arrivals to Europe in 2022, as of 1 Sept 2022; % of 2019 levels









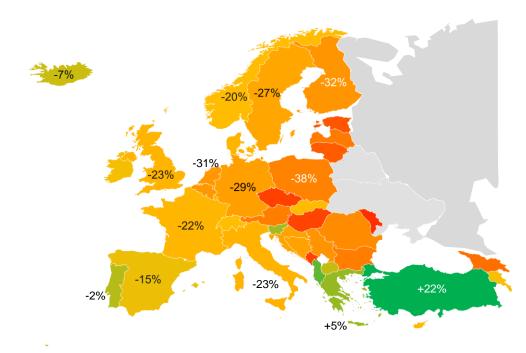

September - November 2022 vs September - November 2019











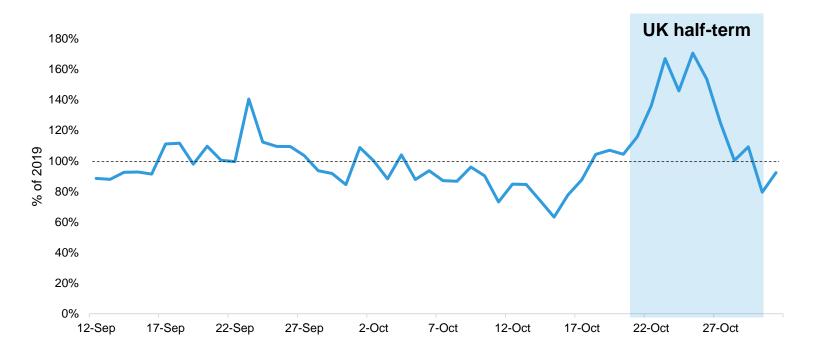

On-the-book UK departures to European destinations, between 12 September and 31 Oct 2022; vs relative period in 2019







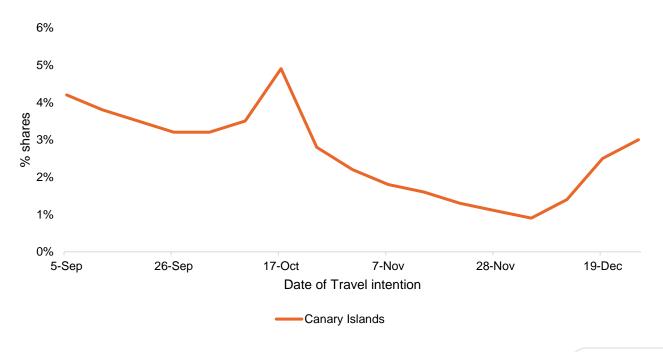




The Canary Islands will be a key destination for Brits this Autumn half-term



Flight Searches to from the UK to Spain between 6 Jun and 28 August 2022, for all future travel











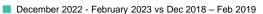


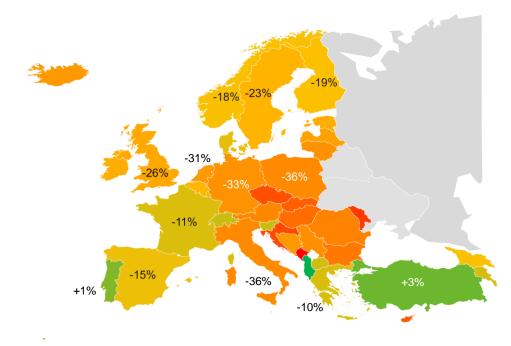
