North West Wales' slate landscape has been awarded World Heritage status and is now Wales' 4th UNESCO World Heritage site. Between 1780 and 1940 the slate industry dominated world production of roofing slates, transforming both the environment and the communities who lived and worked here. Wrexham is currently enjoying increased profile. It received city status in honour of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee in 2022 and American actors, Ryan Reynolds and Rob McElhenney, have become ambassadors for Wrexham since acquiring Wrexham AFC. 'Welcome to Wrexham' reveals the story behind their take-over. The series was premiered in the US and is available via Disney+. Wrexham is the town where the Football Association of Wales was founded in 1876 and a Football Museum for Wales is due to open there in 2024. The **long distance trails of Wales** has launched a bespoke <u>Travel Trade tool kit</u> to support tour operators arranging walking activity in Wales. The walking paths featured include the Wales Coast Path, Offa's Dyke Path, Pembrokeshire Coast Path and Glyndŵr's Way. It provides inspiration, maps and practical information including coach parking and places to eat and drink. To celebrate the **Wales Coast Path**'s 10th anniversary in 2022 new <u>walking itineraries</u> have been developed, some created in partnership with Cadw combining the path's offering with visits to Wales' most iconic castles and historic landmarks. A new <u>app</u> has been launched that helps walkers to track their progress. Those who walk the Wales Coast Path can also buy branded products via the Wales Coast Path <u>Shop</u>. Caernarfon Castle is developing a new accessible visitor centre at the castle's main entrance, the King's Gate. It will include an interactive experience, event space and improved retail space. It will also see new lift and stair access to the Town Walls, two new luxury apartments and significant conservation works to the walled town entrance. Caerphilly Castle is undergoing a £5million renovation scheme that includes a new visitor centre, catering, toilets, digital interpretation of the site and a 13th century makeover of the Great Hall. Penderyn Distillery has opened their new distillery in Llandudno and plan to open another site in Swansea in early 2023. It will be housed in the historic Hafod Morfa Copperworks site. Hensol Gin Distillery, located in the cellars of a 400 year old castle, celebrated its first birthday in September and has been recognised by Tripadvisor as a 2022 Travelers' Choice award winner for being in the 'Top 10% of attractions worldwide'. Albion Aberteifi, a boutique 12 bedroom hotel has opened in the thriving market town of Cardigan, overlooking the river Teifi. The hotel is housed across 2 Grade II listed historic warehouses and the development has kept many original features, celebrating the town's maritime heritage. The name comes from the local legend of the vessel, Albion, which sailed 180 passengers from Cardigan to Canada in 1819. The second phase will see an additional 11 rooms in 2023, along with Yr Odyn restaurant serving the best of local cuisine, including meat from animals reared at fforest farm, with an emphasis on cooking over fire and influences from Scandinavia and Japan. An outdoor sauna and onsen in a private elevated woodland glade house behind the hotel is planned to open in December 2022. Fforest, the outdoor lifestyle pioneer and holiday retreat, also has a range of other accommodation from cabins and glamping tents to farmhouses.
