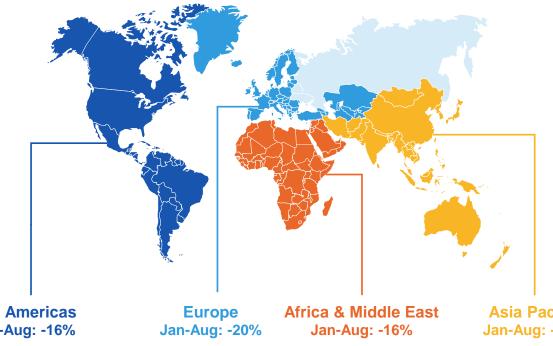

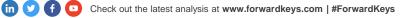

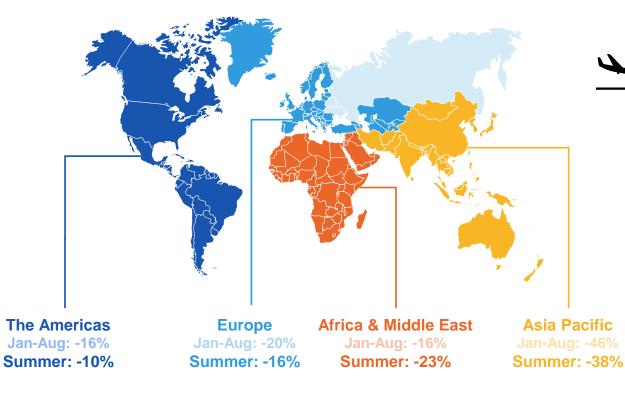

International worldwide arrivals between Jan and August, as of 30 August; vs 2019 levels

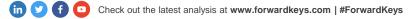

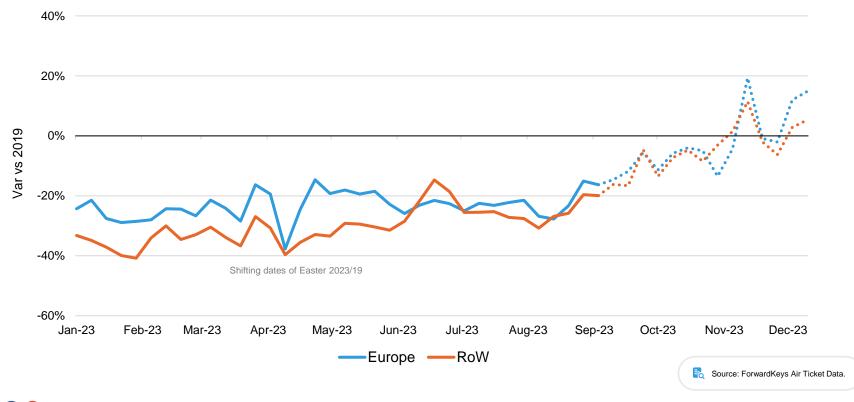

International arrivals in 2023, as of 30 Aug; Var vs 2019

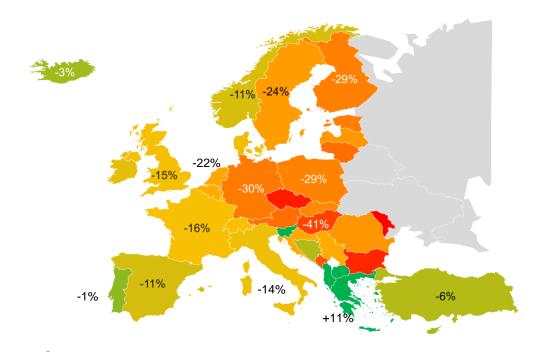

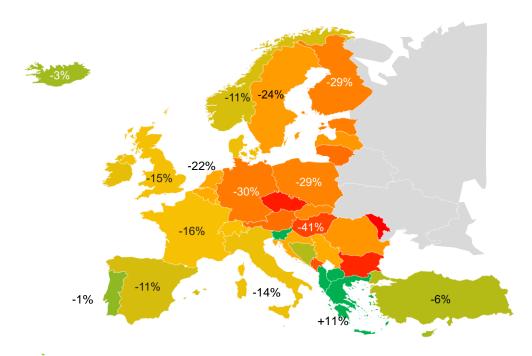

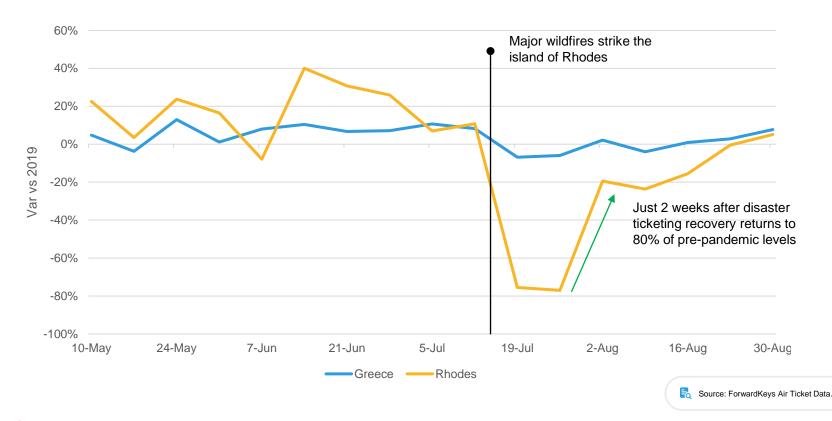

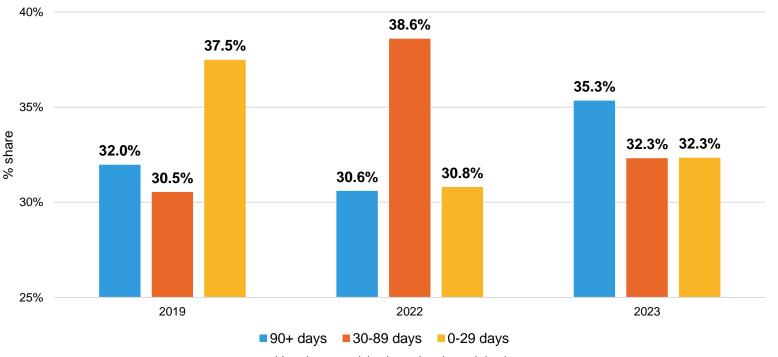

International arrivals to Europe between July and August, segmented by lead-time; vs 2019



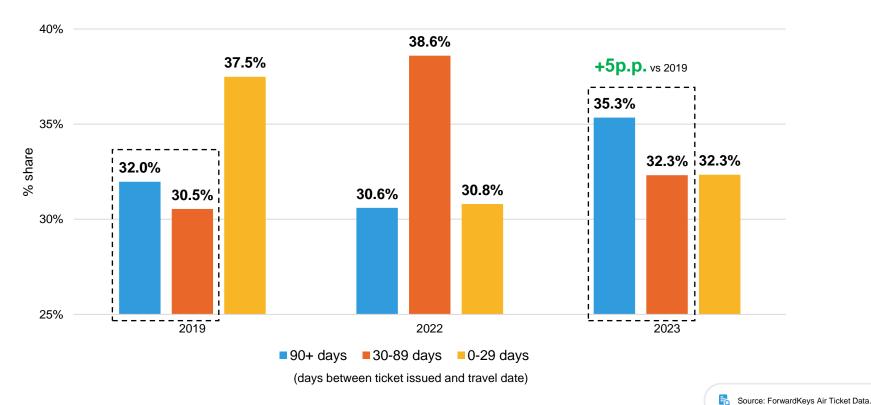

International arrivals to Europe between July and August, segmented by lead-time; vs 2019

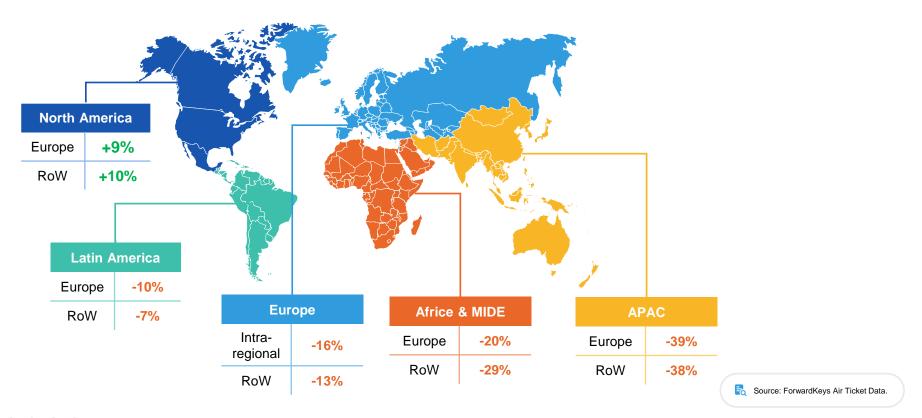


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North America outbound travel keeps growing vs pre-pandemic



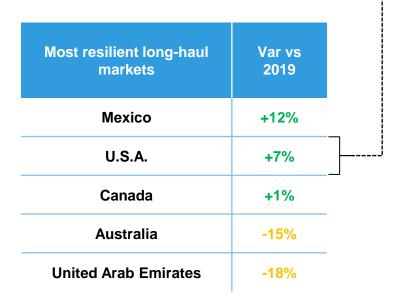
International worldwide departures in July and August, as of 30 August; vs 2019 levels

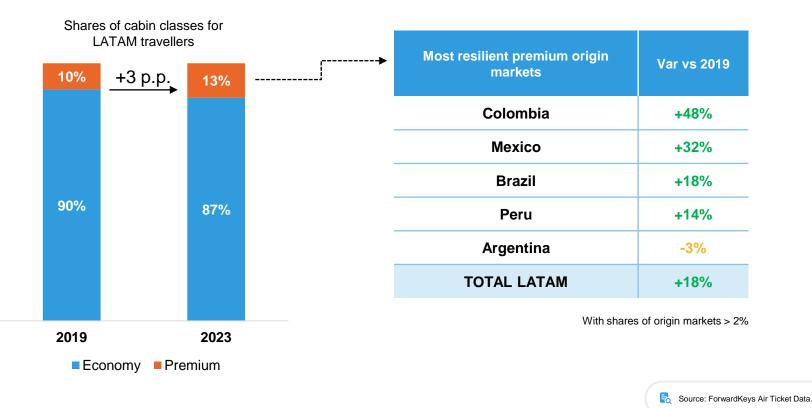

International arrivals from LATAM to Europe in July and Aug, as of 30 Aug; vs 2019 levels

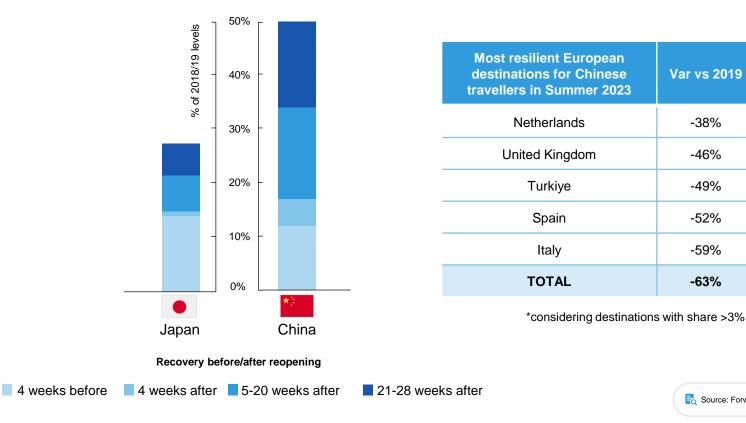




China's phenomenal recovery since reopening outpaces Japan

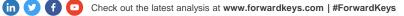

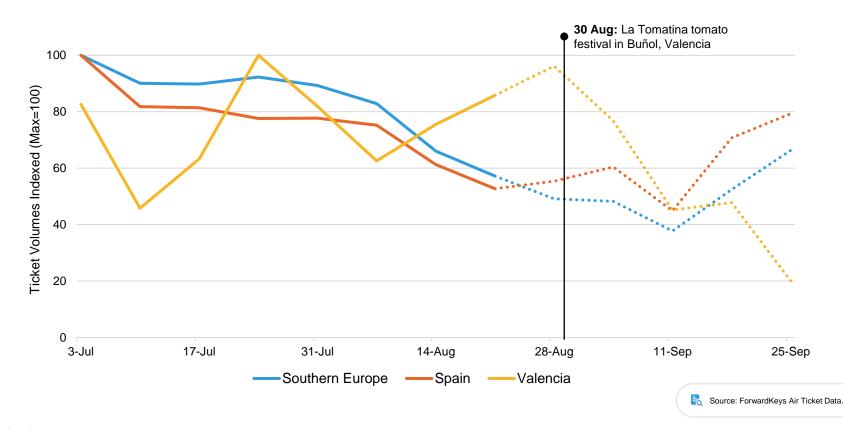

Forward-looking International arrivals from China between July and Sept, as of 18 August 2023

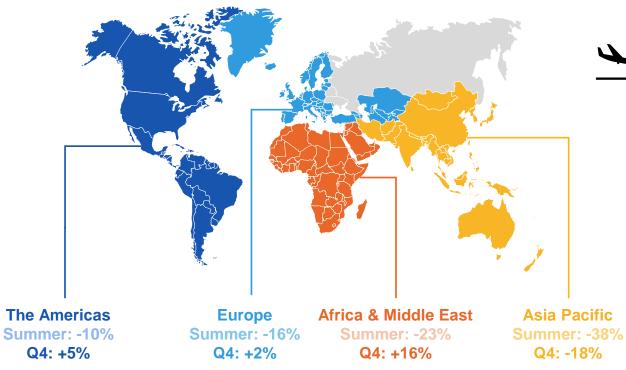

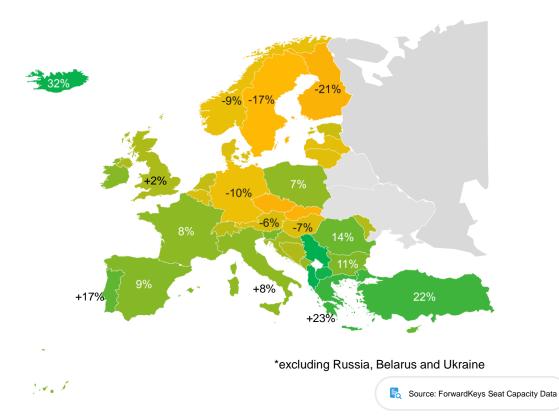
Air supply for Autumn period is improving

Scheduled Seat Capacity for arrivals to Europe between October and December, as of 4 Sept; vs 2019





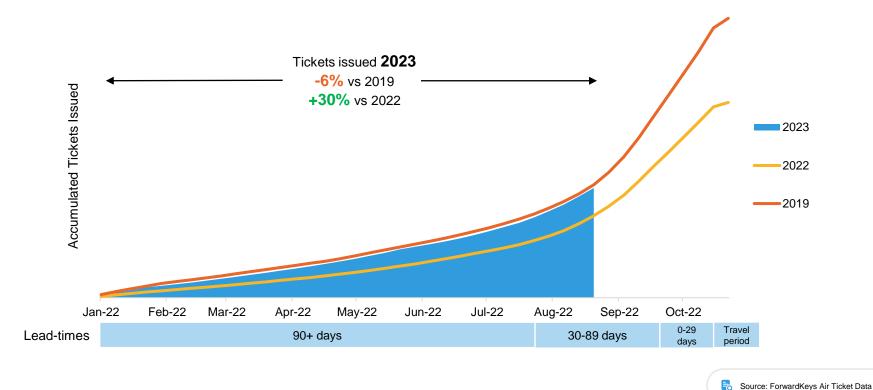

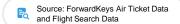
