

Global warming: future projection







EU climate ambition for 2030 & 2050

- The EU adopted the European Climate Law on 30 June 2021
- Union-wide climate-neutrality objective for 2050
- New 2030 target of at least 55% net greenhouse gas emissions reduction
- Recognition of the need to enhance the EU's carbon sink

Road to 2030: Fit for 55 Package






Building resilience – EU Adaptation Strategy

Vision: by 2050 the EU will be a climate-resilient society, fully adapted to the unavoidable impacts of climate change




Coming up: First European Climate Risk Assessment (spring 2024)
