



PARIS RESPIRE

Better quality of life:

- reduced noise pollution,
- improved air quality
- low-impact transport.





THE PROJECT

In order to bring down heavy trafic in the heart of the city and to increase safety, Paris is introducing a LTZ as of mid-October 2024.

After open consultation with professionals in tourism, commerce, culture, events and transports, the City of Paris established the need to implement new trafic regulations in its city center.

THE CONTEXT

Up to 648 coaches per day in Paris in high season (986 pre-Covid).

5% of nitrogen oxides due to trafic are caused by coaches.

In high season, coaches carry 6.5% of incoming tourists in Paris. 50% of coaches are foreign.

9.4% of groups in Paris are school groups.

2.4% are senior groups.

70.7% are tour-operator groups.






THE PROJECT

The city center will remain open to destination trafic: cars, taxis, private hire cars and minivans will be allowed in the perimeter as long as they have a local destination and can prove it.



THE PERIMETER

Only the 4 central arrondissements, not including the islands nor the upper river banks.







THE COACHES

All coaches will be forbidden inside the perimeter 24 / 7.

School coaches and PRM coaches will remain authorized in the perimeter.

The Carrousel du Louvre coach parking (71 underground parking places) will remain accessible, as well as the Cours la Reine parking (55 places, off Concorde square).

Only **electric** coaches up to 15 passengers will be allowed inside the perimeter.

HOP-ON HOP-OFF

Tootbus and Big Bus hop-on hop-off panoramic coaches will have access to the perimeter, being a public transport company.















LOW-EMISSION ZONE

• All vehicles travelling in the Greater Paris area (within the A86 ring road) must display a Crit'Air (air criteria) sticker number 1, 2 or 3.

Diesel engine coaches registered before 1 October 2009, Euro standards 0 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4, are banned from the perimeter 7/7 days from 8am until 8pm.

• From 1 January 2025, diesel engine coaches with Euro standard 5, registered between 2009 and 2013, and petrol engine coaches with Euro standards 3 and 4, registered from 2001 to 30 September 2009, will be banned as well.

At a later date (to be announced) the ban will concern all diesel engine coaches as well as petrol engine coaches with Euro standard 5, registered between 2009 and 2013 and later on all petrol engine coaches as well as gas and hybrid engine coaches with Euro standard 6, registered from 1 January 2014.

Coach traffic in Paris

All vehicles travelling in the Greater Paris area (within the A86 ring road) must display a Crit'Air (air criteria) sticker number 1, 2 or 3.

Diesel engine coaches registered before 1 October 2009, Euro standards 0 – 1 – 2 – 3 – 4, are banned from the perimeter 7/7 days from 8am until 8pm.

The calendar of coach restrictions is as follow:

> 1 January 2025: diesel engine coaches with Euro standard 5, registered between 2009 and 2013, and petrol engine coaches with Euro standards 3 and 4, registered from 2001 to 30 September 2009.

At a later date (to be announced), all diesel engine coaches as well as petrol engine coaches with Euro standard 5, registered between 2009 and 2013 and later on all petrol engine coaches as well as gas and hybrid engine coaches with Euro standard 6, registered from 1 January 2014.

Coach parking in Paris

Stopping to drop off and pick up passengers



Coaches are allowed to stop in Paris. This is free and requires no authorization, providing coaches stop only for the time strictly necessary to drop off or pick up passengers, with or without the loading/unloading of luggage. The engine must be switched off.

There are 56 on-street designated places for coaches to pick up/drop off passengers. In addition, there are delivery areas as well as places within the immediate vicinity of hotels and sports and cultural venues

to pick up/drop off passengers.

Parking



Parking charges apply to all coaches in Paris 24/24 and 7/7 and the coach parking pass 'PASS Autocar' is obligatory.

THE RESOURCES

Paris je t'aime keeps up to date with regulations and informs profesionnals on all coach matters.

Our online resources include Crit'air sticker information, diesel restrictions calender, drop-off and parking rules and locations, PASS Autocar parking permit and charges as well as a list of local coach operators for hire.

THE PASS AUTOCAR

Compulsory 24 / 7 to park in Paris www.passautocar.paris.fr

2-hour parking in Central Paris (arrondissements 1-11) or 4 hours in the Peripheral zone (arrondissements 12-20): From €15 (clean vehicles) to €90 (Euro 4 coaches) for regular users, Or

From €109.50 (online purchase) to €121.50 (payment onsite) for occasional users, €55 for school coaches & PRM with advanced booking.
